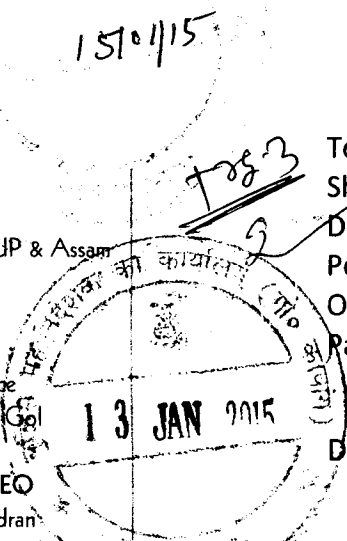

The Police Institute, through a series of carefully thought out and well calibrated strategic initiatives, will work towards realizing the overall Vision of the Police Foundation.
